- I. Meeting called to order at 6:00 p.m. at Black Bear Restaurant, Visalia, California.
- II. Moment of Silence for deceased MAGA members.
- III. Approval of Agenda- M/S/C Tino Serrato/Lupe Mendoza to accept the agenda.
- IV. Correspondence and Announcements-Reminder Madera Mandatory July 20, 2025, at Madera Country Club, so far 15 members from Visalia-Tulare signed up. 2025 State Tournament August 29-31 at Menifee Lakes Golf Course and Golf Club of Rancho California. - Mercy Calistro services fund raiser- Breakdown of \$941.00 donations received: Major donor Adrian Herrera (\$500.00) minus expenses \$468.98 (flowers, pastries, water and sodas) and \$100.00 “In Memory sign”. Balance to \$372.02 to Joe G. Calistro. M/S/C Tino Serrato/Lupe Mendoza to reimburse Tino and Mary Serrato \$182.40 for the purchase of items for the service.
- Not posting scores- Discussion held on members that do not post their scores problem and what action can be taken. M/S/C Tino Serrato/Lupe Mendoza that we have a policy that a member have a two day grace period to post their scores, if not posted the member will be posted a 72 by Handicap Chairman.
